AIS Office Position Open:

Help us to thank Nancy B for the last 10 years of service she has given to our Portland AIS. Nancy's last day will be November 21st. At this time the Board will do our best to keep the office open in person on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursdays. If possible, contact the office prior to coming up. AIS currently has a paid job-share position open, which consists of 16-24 hours/week between the hours of 9am-5pm. A requirement for the position is that the applicant must be an active member of AI-Anon for a minimum of one year. Per the AIS Bylaws, applicants cannot also be a member of AA and if the applicant accepts the position, they would no longer be able to hold any position beyond the group level. This position focuses on bookkeeping, payroll & tax filings for a 501(c)3. Additional skills needed include data entry, composition of documents & business letters, knowledge of AI-Anon literature and ability to work well with the public, other members, and co-workers.

If you believe your skillset can satisfy the skills listed above, please consider applying for this position. Training will be made available for all elements of the job.

OFFICE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:

AIS needs volunteers who'd be available to fill in for a few hours during times when our special workers need to be out of the office. Volunteers don't have to be able to answer every question, and they can always tell a caller they're a volunteer and will pass on a message to the office staff who will be back in the office on such and such a day.

Very little training is necessary but we ask that prospective volunteers spend a couple of hours with office staff for a short orientation which explains procedures and how to write up literature sales. Some volunteers bring an iPad to access our website for meeting information or do so on their phones, and those who work virtually and can spare a few hours to help occasionally can bring a laptop and work from the office where there is wi-fi.

Without volunteers to help, our office will be forced to close on days when the regular staff are not available. This doesn't happen often but until this situation is resolved we suggest that you call before coming to the office to be sure someone is there.

Remember that the AIS office is on a hill and for the safety of our staff and membership the office hours will be adjusted on the fly during incremental weather. Please email the office prior to coming to ensure that we are there to greet you. Thank you for your understanding.




THANK YOU to the Greater Portland Al-Anon community for the success of our 2023 AIS Fundraiser!!!

WISDOM SHARED... EXCERPTS FROM "HOPE FOR TODAY" NOVEMBER 2ND;

To me recovery is intertwined with service, and the business of Al-Anon is about service performed by the entire group. The Traditions keep us focused on the *business of service*. For example, part of Tradition Five helps us focus on Al-Anon's reason for being-helping families and friends of alcoholics.

Someone needs to take responsibility for the service functions of our worldwide fellowship, and that "someone" is each of us, the individual groups. Because we are fully self-supporting, as Tradition Seven states, no one else provides funds for the business.

Al-Anon didn't just happen. There were and are many people behind the scenes making sure it survives. A group that pays attention to its affairs in all areas is a healthy group. To do my part, all it takes is a little willingness to attend the business meetings and to keep an open mind.

Al-Anon's Three Legacies encompass Recovery through the STEPS, Unity through the TRADITIONS, and Service through the CONCEPTS. Adopted almost word for word from Alcoholics Anonymous, the Twelve Steps of Al-Anon are the Steps followed by each of us along this very personal path to recovery.

AN AL-ANON INFORMATION SERVICE USUALLY PERFORMS THE FOLLOWING FUNCTIONS:

- MAINTAINS A LISTING IN THE LOCAL PHONE DIRECTORY SO THAT THOSE SEEKING INFORMATION ABOUT AL-ANON AND ALATEEN CAN EASILY FIND IT.
- MAINTAINS A POST OFFICE BOX OR AN OFFICE ADDRESS FOR LISTING WITH THE WORLD SERVICES OFFICE.
- RECEIVES POSTAL MAIL, E-MAIL AND PHONE INQUIRIES, AND FORWARDS THEM TO THE APPROPRIATE GROUP FOR RESPONSE OR FOLLOW-UP.
- IN COOPERATION WITH THE AREA GROUP RECORDS COORDINATOR, UPDATES, PUB-LISHES AND DISTRIBUTES LISTS OF GROUP MEETINGS IN THEIR LOCAL AREA.
- PLANS AND CONDUCTS PROGRAM-EXCHANGE MEETINGS WHERE THE GROUPS' CHAIRPERSONS OR PROGRAM
 CHAIRPERSONS EXCHANGE TEAM OF SPEAKERS FOR A SCHEDULED PERIOD.
- SERVES AS AN AVENUE FOR LOCAL PUBLIC OUTREACH SERVICE, WHICH IS CHAN-NELED THROUGH THE DISTRICTS WHENEVER POSSIBLE.
- MAY MAINTAIN A STOCK OF CONFERENCE APPROVED LITERATURE (CAL) AND MAY REGISTER WITH THE WSO AS A LITERATURE DISTRIBUTION CENTER (LDC) TO SELL CAL.
- MAY MAINTAIN A WEB SITE THAT IS LINKED TO THEIR AREA WEB SITE.
- HOLDS PERIODIC MEETINGS ATTENDED BY ALL THE INFORMATION SERVICE REPRE-SENTATIVES WHERE ACTIVITY REPORTS, INCLUDING A FINANCIAL UPDATE, ARE MADE AND MATTERS REGARDING GROUPS ARE DISCUSSED.
- PRINTS AND DISTRIBUTES ITS OWN NEWSLETTER OF LOCAL AL-ANON/ALATEEN ACTIVI-TIES FOR THE GROUPS THAT SUPPORT IT."
